

CMT COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES WINTER/SPRING 2025

The health and safety of our students and staff remain our highest priority. All plans for rehearsals, performances, classes and camps will follow county guidelines to help protect all who participate.

Below, you will find a summary of actions we are taking to help ensure we are lowering COVID-19 risk as much as possible:

- ✓ All staff members are required to be vaccinated.
- ✓ All eligible participants are strongly encouraged to be vaccinated.
- ✓ Masks are voluntary while indoors at the Creative Arts Center. All performances are performed without masks.
- ✓ We will continue to intensify cleaning and disinfection practices within our facilities and arrange for frequent deep cleaning by janitorial staff after hours.
- ✓ Healthy hygiene practices are encouraged through the Creative Arts Center, emphasizing the importance of washing hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Sanitizer stations are also located throughout the rehearsal studios.
- ✓ Families are required to screen their children for COVID related symptoms and keep them home should any develop.
- ✓ Participants who test positive for COVID must self-quarantine for 5 days. On day 5, participants may test at home and return the following day with a negative test. If still testing positive, participants should continue to test daily and may return once the result is negative. After 10 days, symptom-free participants may return regardless of testing status.
- ✓ No refunds will be given for cancellations requested due to COVID related absences.

All participants are required to acknowledge their understanding of the plan outlined above by checking off on the COVID Health and Safety Waiver upon registration.
